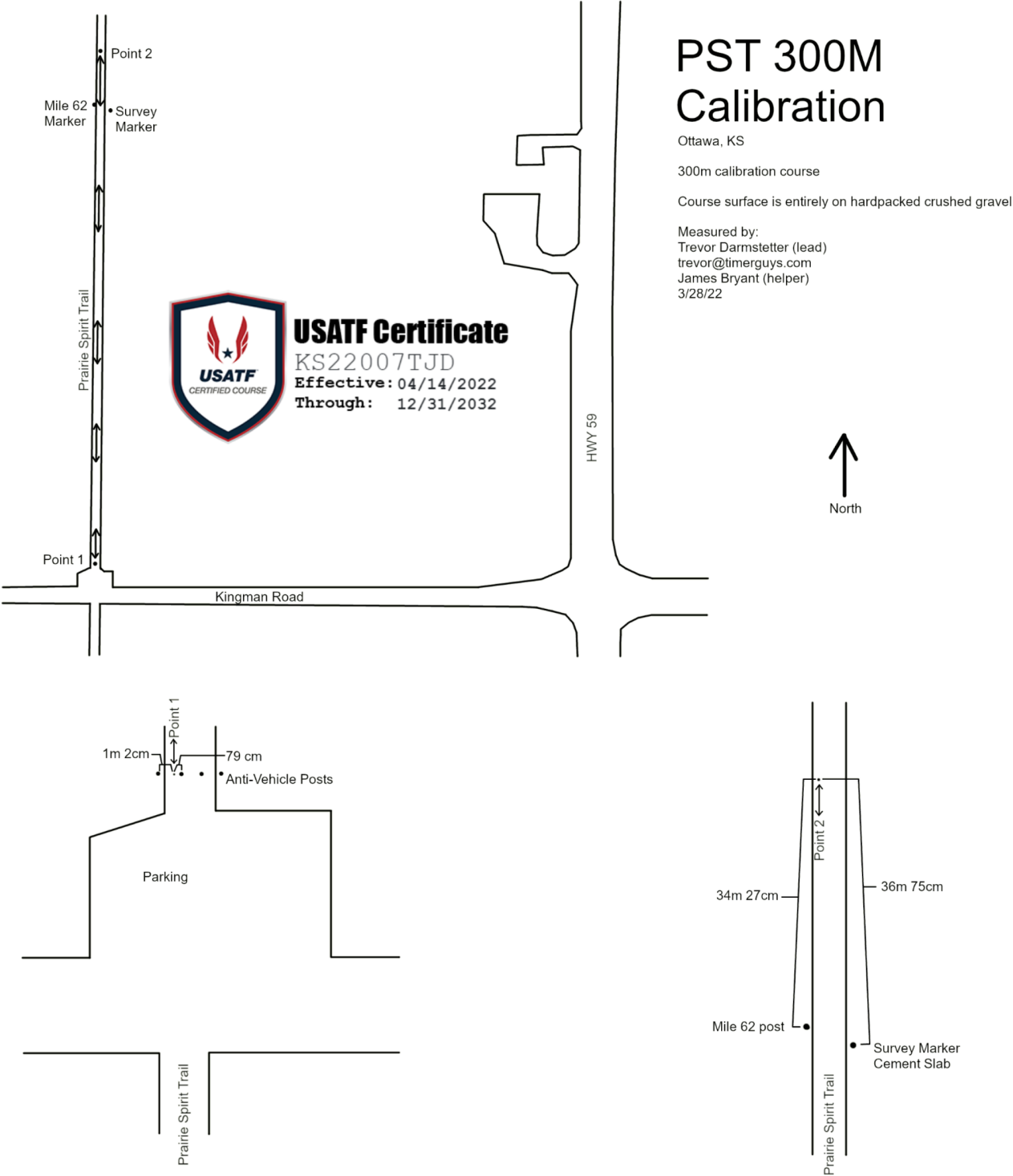

Point 1 - 1m 2cm from the base of the westernmost anti-vehicle post on the trail just north of the parking area. 79cm from the base of the second post from the west.

Point 2 - 34m 27cm from the base of the Mile 62 wooden post marker. 36m 75cm from the northwest corner of the cement slab housing the survey marker L2571938
