The west pin is defined as being 51' 10" from a picnic sign on the north side of the road and 33' 7.5" from the western-most post of a split rail fence next to the picnic sign. The pin is painted steel rebar.

The east pin is defined as being 11' 10" from utility pole 14E/114/A99/18 on the south side of the road and 66' 8.5" from a speed limit sign on the north side of the road. The pin is painted steel rebar.
