The course was measured as the **shortest possible route and runners have full access to the roads**. The portion of the run along West Blvd is run on the sidewalk.

Starting on 7th Ave SW, run east to 1st St S and turn left, heading north. At 1st Ave SE, turn left and run clockwise around the courthouse running the tangents. Complete a full circle of the courthouse and turn left onto 1st Ave SE, heading east to 2nd St SE and turn right, heading south. Run south to 17th Ave SE and turn right heading west. Cross South Main St and transition to the sidewalks on the south side of West Blvd. After the 3-mile mark, turn left into the City Rec Trail, running south. At Cherokee Dr SW, turn right. Run the full length of Cherokee Dr until it intersects with the City Rec Trail, turn right heading south again. The Rec Trail next intersects with Clubview Dr., turn right, and run west to Wiregrass Cir, turn left. Next, turn right at Hummingbird Ln, then right at Pine Cone Rd and back to Wiregrass Cir, turning right. Next, turn left (east) onto Clubview Dr and exit the neighborhood and back to the City Rec Trail, turning right and south. Take the trail south almost to the end where it intersects Veterans Pky. Uturn, now heading north. Run the City Rec Trail about 4 miles, passing 9,10,11,12 and 13 miles on the trail. After passing 13 miles, turn right at 7th Ave SW and veer right finishing in the semi-circular driveway of the Moultrie Arts Center, where the 5K and 10K also finish.

START/ FINISH: In circular driveway of Moultrie Arts Center, even with pole# 5130 also almost dead even with the theatre doors of Arts Center

U-TURN: On City Rec Trail, south of driveway of house # 4244, 138'8' south of trail security bollard, but north of Veterans Hwy.

The course was measured as the **shortest possible route and runners have full access to the roads**. The portion of the run along West Blvd is run on the sidewalk.

Starting on 7th Ave SW, run east to 1st St S and turn left, heading north. At 1st Ave SE, turn left and run clockwise around the courthouse running the tangents. Complete a full circle of the courthouse and turn left onto 1st Ave SE, heading east to 2st St SE and turn right, heading south. Run south to 17th Ave SE and turn right heading west. Cross South Main St and transition to the sidewalks on the south side of West Blvd. After the 3-mile mark, turn left into the City Rec Trail, running south. At Cherokee Dr SW, turn right. Run the full length of Cherokee Dr until it intersects with the City Rec Trail, turn right heading south again. The Rec Trail next intersects with Clubview Dr., turn right, and run west to Wiregrass Cir, turn left. Next, turn right at Hummingbird Ln, then right at Pine Cone Rd and back to Wiregrass Cir, turning right. Next, turn left (east) onto Clubview Dr and exit the neighborhood and back to the City Rec Trail, turning right and south. Take the trail south almost to the end where it intersects Veterans Pky. U-turn, now heading north. Run the City Rec Trail about 4 miles, passing 9,10,11,12 and 13 miles on the trail. After passing 13 miles, turn right at 7th Ave SW and veer right finishing in the semi-circular driveway of the Moultrie Arts Center, where the 5K and 10K also finish.

START: In circular driveway of Moultrie Arts Center, even with pole# 5130 also almost dead even with the theatre doors of Arts Center

MILE 1: On 1st St SE, the mark is on west side of 1st ST SE, (Courthouse side) even with water meter cover on sidewalk and south of old-fashioned black light post. Opposite store #7 1st St SE, currently occupied by Klutch 21 Boutique.

MILE 2: Mark is located on west side of 2nd St SE, even with water meter on lawn of house # 1154. Also, opposite pole #5711

MILE 3: On sidewalk on south side of West Blvd, 107'1' east of pole #6159, which is on woods side of small culvert.

MILE 4: On north side of Cherokee Rd SW, near mailbox of house #8, also 68'5" east of pole 4643 located on south side of Cherokee Rd SW

MILE 5: On City Rec Trail, 60'3" north of green Pole labeled Tom White Linear Park. The Belk Shopping Plaza and a Bridgestone sign are on the east side of S Main St.

MILE 6: On Clubview Dr, west of the driveway of house # 301, also west of pole on north side of Clubview.

MILE 7: On south side of Pine Cone Rd, near corner of Hummingbird Ln, 34'10" east of fire hydrant and manhole cover of 41 Pine Cone Rd.

MILE 8: Across from driveway of house 103 Golfview Dr, on north side of the road. Also 118'0" east of pole L11253

U-TURN: On City Rec Trail, south of driveway of house # 4244, 138'8' south of trail security bollard, but north of Veterans Hwy.

MILE 9: On City Rec Trail, 141' 0" north of yellow and blue Gas Line Marker, between trail and Main St.

MILE 10: On City Rec Trail, about midway between 19th Hole Lane of Sunset Country Club and Hugh Banister Rd to the south. Directly across from Ellianos Coffee, mailbox #2803 S Main St

MILE 11: On City Rec Trail, 70'11" north of cement corner of white wooden shelter to the east of the trail. Across from 2033 S Main St.

MILE 12: On City Rec Trail, north of West Blvd, 52'3" north of pole #8123

MILE 13: On City Rec Trail, 81'6" north of pole 5117 on east side of trail, also between 15^{th} and 16^{th} cement fence post.

The course was measured as the **shortest possible route and runners have full access to the roads**. The portion of the run along West Blvd is run on the sidewalk.

START: In circular driveway of Moultrie Arts Center, even with pole# 5130 also almost dead even with the theatre doors of Arts Center

MILE 1: On 1** St SE, the mark is on west side of 1** ST SE, (Courthouse side) even with water meter cover on sidewalk and south of old-fashioned black light post. Opposite store #7 1** St SE, currently occupied by Klutch 21 Boutique.

MILE 2: Mark is located on west side of 2nd St SE, even with water meter on lawn of house # 1154. Also, opposite pole #5711

MILE 3: On sidewalk on south side of West Blvd, 107'1' east of pole #6159, which is on woods side of small culvert.

MILE 4: On north side of Cherokee Rd SW, near mailbox of house #8, also 68'5" east of pole 4643 located on south side of Cherokee Rd SW

MILE 5: On City Rec Trail, 60'3" north of green Pole labeled Tom White Linear Park. The Belk Shopping Plaza and a Bridgestone sign are on the east side of S Main St.

MILE 6: On Clubview Dr, west of the driveway of house # 301, also west of pole on north side of Clubview.

MILE 7: On south side of Pine Cone Rd, near corner of Hummingbird Ln, 34'10" east of fire hydrant and manhole cover of 41 Pine Cone Rd.

MILE 8: Across from driveway of house 103 Golfview Dr, on north side of the road. Also 118'0" east of pole L11253

U-TURN: On City Rec Trail, south of driveway of house # 4244, 138'8' south of trail security bollard, but north of Veterans Hwy.

MILE 9: On City Rec Trail, 141' 0" north of yellow and blue Gas Line Marker, between trail and Main St.

MILE 10: On City Rec Trail, about midway between 19th Hole Lane of Sunset Country Club and Hugh Banister Rd to the south. Directly across from Ellianos Coffee, mailbox #2803 S Main St

MILE 11: On City Rec Trail, 70'11" north of cement corner of white wooden shelter to the east of the trail. Across from 2033 S Main St.

MILE 12: On City Rec Trail, north of West Blvd, 52'3" north of pole #8123

MILE 13: On City Rec Trail, 81'6" north of pole 5117 on east side of trail, also between 15th and 16th cement fence post.

FINISH: In circular driveway of Moultrie Arts Center, even with pole# 5130 also almost dead even with the theatre doors of Arts Center
