

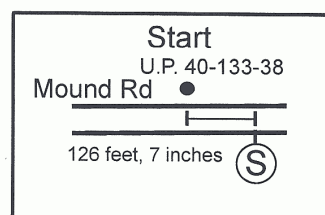
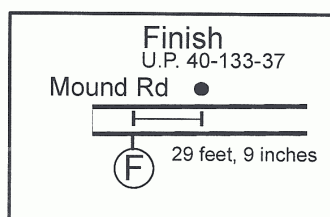
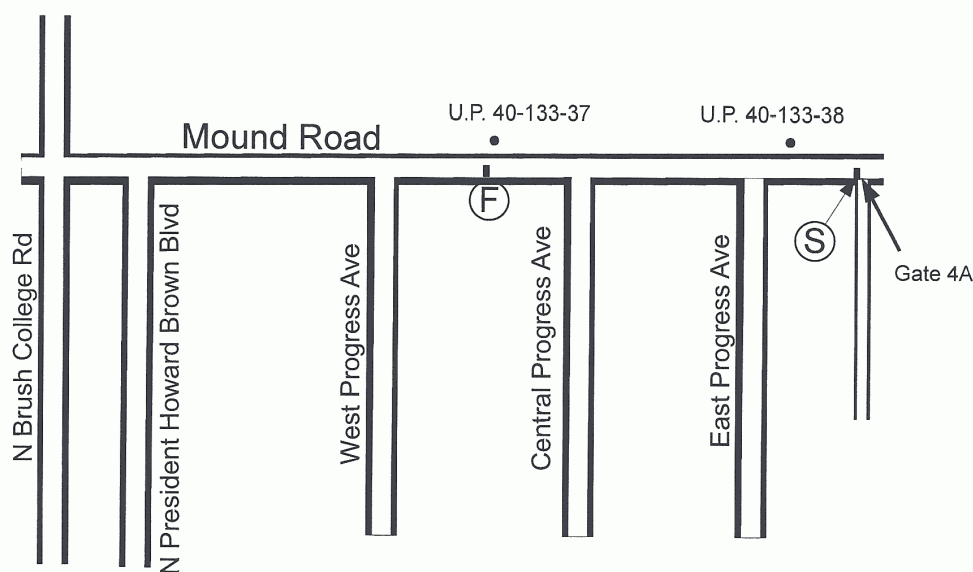


Mound Road ¼ Mile Calibration Course

Start: At center of pole at West side of entrance for Gate 4A, just East of East Progress Avenue. Also 126 feet, 7 inches East of center of utility pole 40-133-38.

Finish: 29 feet, 9 inches West of center of utility pole 40-133-37 between Central Progress Avenue and West Progress Avenue.
