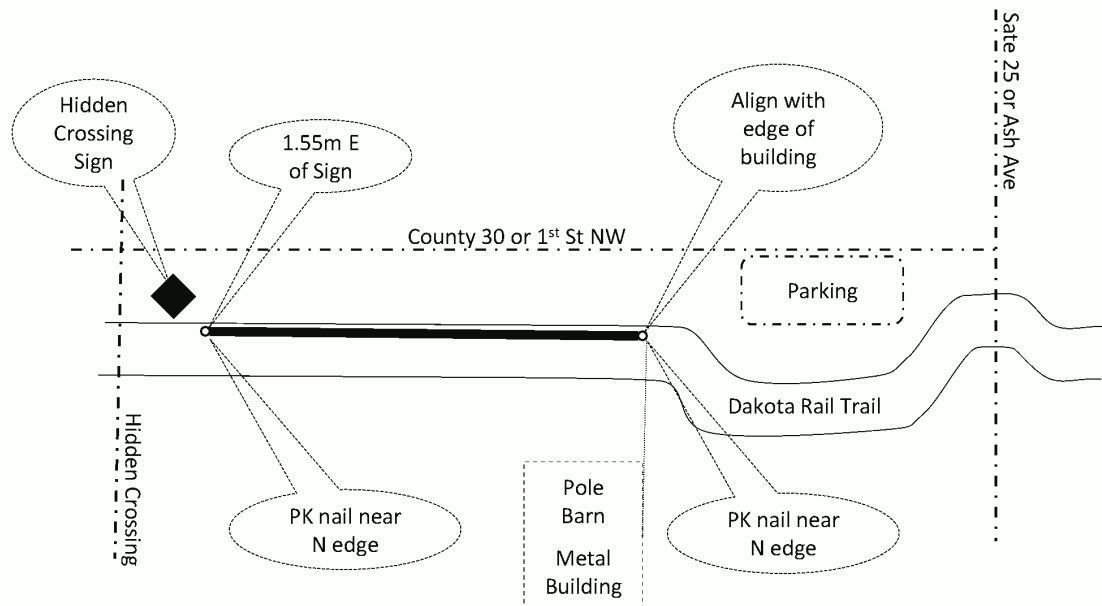

On the Dakota Rail Trail in Mayer, MN

East End: West of Ash St. West of “wiggle” around parking lot on the SW corner of Ash and 1st. Align with the East edge of the pole barn on the South side of the trail. PK nail on north side of trail. PK originally painted White.

West End: East of Hidden Crossing Rd. 1.55m East of “Hidden Crossing” sign on the North side of the trail. PK nail on north side of trail. PK originally painted White.
