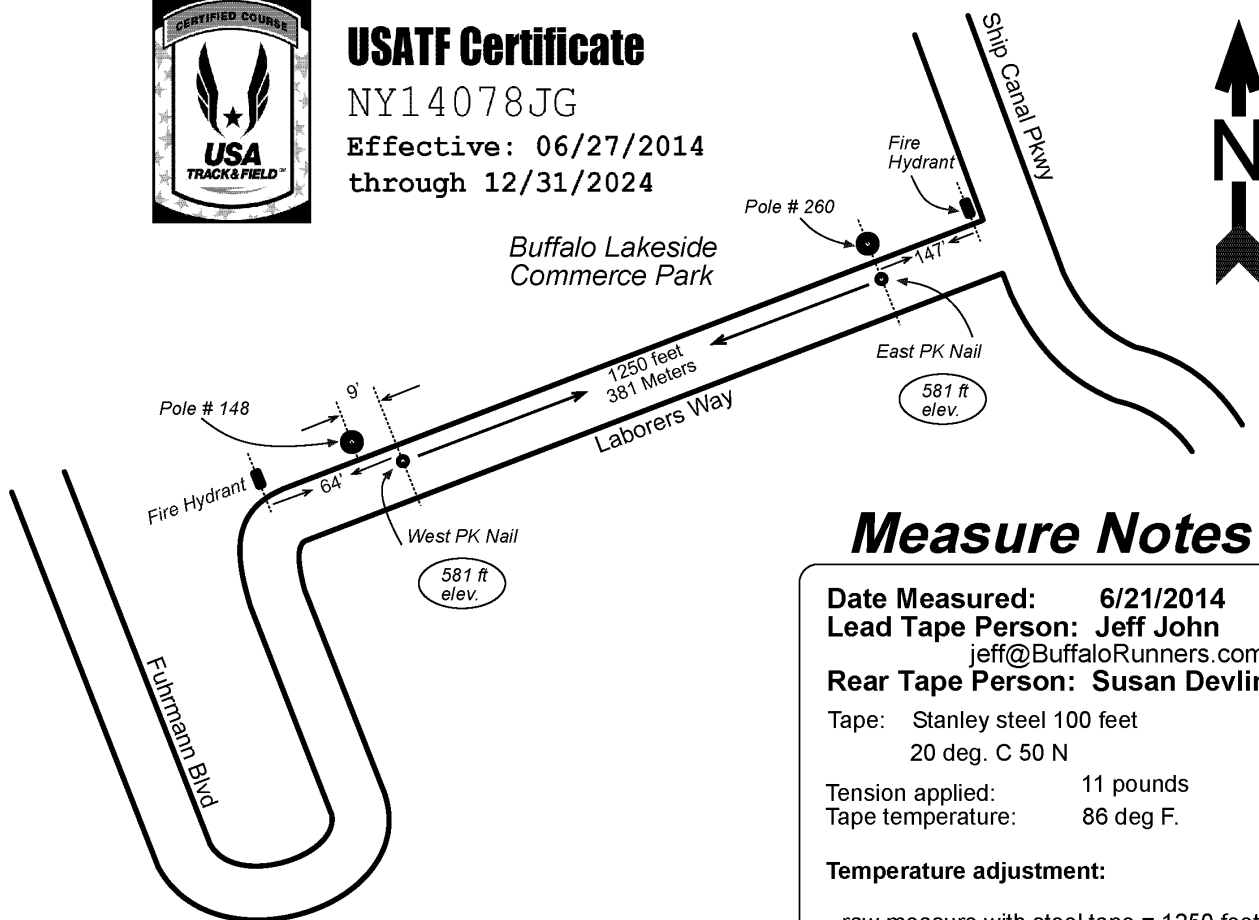

## Course Notes

Calibration Course defined by PK Nails.

Nails are 18 inches from the north curb of Laborers Way.

Locations marked by white paint stripes. The PK Nails have yellow survey disks for increased visibility.

EAST PK NAIL is in-line with the center of Pole # 260 and 147' west of the fire hydrant near intersect with Ship Canal Pkwy.

WEST PK NAIL is 9' east of the center of Pole # 148 and 64' east of the fire hydrant closest to Fuhrmann Blvd.

### Temperature adjustment:

raw measure with steel tape = 1250 feet

$1250 \times (1 + ((86-68) \times 0.00000645)) =$   
1250.14500 feet  
0.145 feet long  
shortened 1.74 inches.

**NOTE:** This new road was previously named "Susquehanna Pkwy" and may appear on maps as such, or erroneously as "Fuhrmann Blvd". The name "Laborers Way" was officially adopted by Buffalo City Council action on 8/29/2012. New signage is in place.
