

The 1,000 foot calibration course is defined by Survey nails. If the nails are missing then the course is void.

West Survey Nail: On the north side of Franklin St at the STOP Sign at intersect with N Central Ave, and 70' 1" west of red fire hydrant.

East Survey Nail: North side of Franklin St near the intersect with N Buffalo St, and 14' 2" east of sign "No Standing Here To Corner".
