Marathon Mile Marks: (All Mile marks are on Eisenbahn Trail)

Start: 72'-4" north of concrete corner of 4th park bench north of Hy 33 (at end of Riverside Drive)

1 Mile: 92' northwest of concrete sidewalk on north side of Barton Avenue

2 Mile: 48' north of power line pole #978, 3rd pole south of Lighthouse Lane

3 Mile: 39' south of buried fiber optical cable marker WI 02-1397, across from Golden Chicken sign along Hy 45.

4 Mile: 426' south of Washington County Mile 5 Marker

5 Mile: 256' south of Washington County Mile 4 Marker

6 Mile: 14'-6" south of pavement at Sandy Ridge Road (north entrance)

7 Mile: 587' south of trail stop sign on south side of Hy 28 (Main St)

8 Mile: Middle of Hy 45 bridge over Eisenbahn Tr.

9 Mile: 16' southeast of Washington County ATV Status sign south of wood bridge south of Rustic Dr

10 Mile: 120' northwest of wood bridge between Rustic Drive and Maple Drive

11 Mile: North edge of concrete culvert north of Auburn-Ashford Drive

12 Mile: 28' north of pavement of Century Drive

13 Mile: 12' south of sidewalk on south side of Campbellsport Drive

Turn-around: 514'-3" north of pavement of Campbellsport Drive

14 Mile: 1183' north of Century Drive

15 Mile: 462' southeast of power building south of Haven Drive

16 Mile: 25' southeast of Buddenhagen bench northwest of Maple Drive (Bench is 420 feet southeast of small bridge northwest of Maple Drive)

17 Mile: 185' north of large wood bridge south of Maple Dr. (also 2nd bridge north of W. Moraine Dr)

18 Mile: 635' southeast of Trail stop sign on south side of driveway at Town of Kewaskum 9485 sign (also 85' south of Hy 45 & End V signs)

19 Mile: 45' northwest of Trail stop sign on north side of 1st Street

20 Mile: 640' north of "Kewaskum Women's Club" bench, north of Sandy Ridge Road (north entrance)

21 Mile: 94' north of wood bridge south of County "A"

22 Mile: 715' north of Washington County Mile 5 Marker

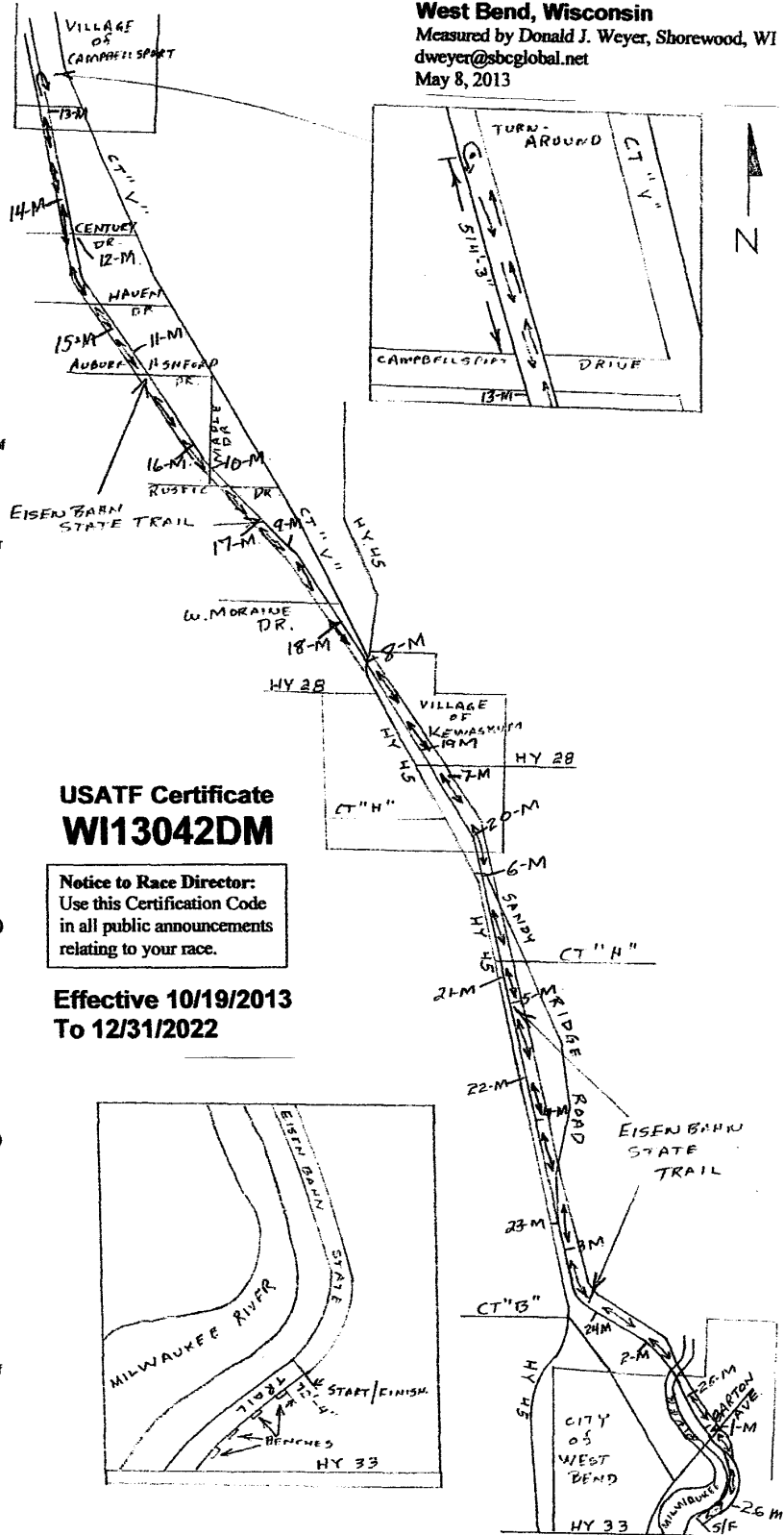
23 Mile: 183' south of end of bridge south of Sandy Ridge Road (south entrance)

24 Mile: 50' south of power pole #976 south of Lighthouse Lane

25 Mile: 128' south of Jim Kaeding bench, north of Mies Products building
